

**BINGEN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES**  
**Special Meeting – Fundraising Workshop**

**January 17, 2012**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Betty Barnes at 6:00 p.m. Council members present: Laura Mann, Sandi Dickey, Maria Perez, Catherine Kiewit, Rosi Salguero. Council members absent: Clinton Bryan. City Administrator Jan Brending and City Attorney Tad Connors were present. Audience: John Newman.

The city council discussed holding a fundraiser for the skatepark.
