The City of Bingen shoreline jurisdiction consisting of approximately 2.5 miles of shoreline and 55 acres of upland shorelands located within portions of Section 29 and 30, Township 3 North, Range 11 East, Willamette Meridian located in Klickitat County and the City of White Salmon, portions of Sections 23, 24, and 25, Township 3 North, Range 10 East, and Sections 19 and 30, Township 3 North, Range 11 East, Willamette Meridian located in Klickitat County.

#### Lead Agency

City of Bingen
