

**CITY OF BINGEN
PUBLIC NOTICE
APPLICATION FOR COVERAGE
UNDER THE GENERAL PERMIT FOR BIOSOLIDS MANAGEMENT**

Notice is hereby given that City of Bingen has submitted an application to the Department of Ecology to obtain coverage under the General Permit for Biosolids Management issued in August 2015. A copy of the general permit can be found at:

The City of Bingen has reviewed documentation previously submitted in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) and has determined that for the purposes of this proposal, SEPA requirements have been satisfied.

The City of Bingen applies biosolids as a soil amendment. Land application sites are located at Max Fernandez Ranch, 773 Uecker Road, Centerville, WA 98613, and is described as portions of Section 24 and 25, Township 3 North, Range 14 East (Tax Lots 03142400000500, 03142500000600, and 03142500000300) and portions of Section 30 and 19, Township 3 North Range 15 East (Tax Lots 03153000000300, 03153000000200, and 03151900000400). W.M., Klickitat County Washington. Our permit application includes a Site Specific Land Application Plan that address the management of our biosolids at these sites. Our permit application includes a General Land Application Plan that addresses how future land application sites will be identified and managed. Proposals for new sites will be consistent with our General Land Application Plan, and additional environmental review will be completed if needed. Public notice at proposed new sites will include a 30-day comment period, and signs will be posted around the proposed sites.

Any person who wants to comment on this proposal or to request a public hearing or meeting must do so, in writing. Comments or requests must be submitted to Peter Severtson, Washington Department of Ecology by December 21.

The City of Bingen will provide written confirmation by certified mail, return receipt requested, to each interested person or organization that their name has been placed on the list.
