UPDATE: City Hall Closure to remain in effect until April 27, 2020

The Bingen City Council meeting scheduled for March 17, 2020 has been cancelled and Bingen City Hall will be temporarily closed to the public. This is a precautionary social distancing measure to limit the spread of COVID-19 and protect the vulnerable members of our community, staff, and families.

During this closure, payments may be left in the drop box outside City Hall, made over the phone, or sent in via the mail. City employees will be available by phone and email during normal business hours: Tuesday-Friday, 8:00am ó 5:00pm.
